

A+G COVIDSafe Privacy Statement

At Ainslie and Gorman Arts Centres, we care about your privacy and we understand how important it is to protect the information you have given us. We are bound by the *Privacy Act 1988 (Cth)* and *Section 16A* which sets out a number of principles concerning the privacy of individuals.

The information that A+G collects as part of our COVIDSafe sign-in procedures is used only in the interest of public safety.

The only time that this data will be used is to identify COVID related risks and to notify any instances of community transmission to the ACT Health Authorities.

This information will not be used for any other purpose.

Once sign-in sheets have been filled in, they are then stored securely (under lock and key) in our offices, and are destroyed after 28 days – as per Federal Government Recommendations

In the interest of public safety if you refuse to comply with Ainslie and Gorman Arts Centres sign-in procedures you may be denied access to the premises.

We make sure anyone working with or for us understands the importance of keeping any records we collect private and secure.

We make sure the information we do collect is for Centre specific activities or safety purposes only.
